It's tough, but he has regular progress checks with the college and has learned, over time, to balance his work with the gym, reading and generally switching off.

Support from mentors like his line manager, a welcoming team, and a culture that values progression and well-being have all had a big impact on Ollie's progress here. The Trust pays well above the apprentice living wage, promotes people internally, and creates space for people to thrive.

Ollie's advice to those starting out: "Do it. I've never regretted joining. It's changed my life."
