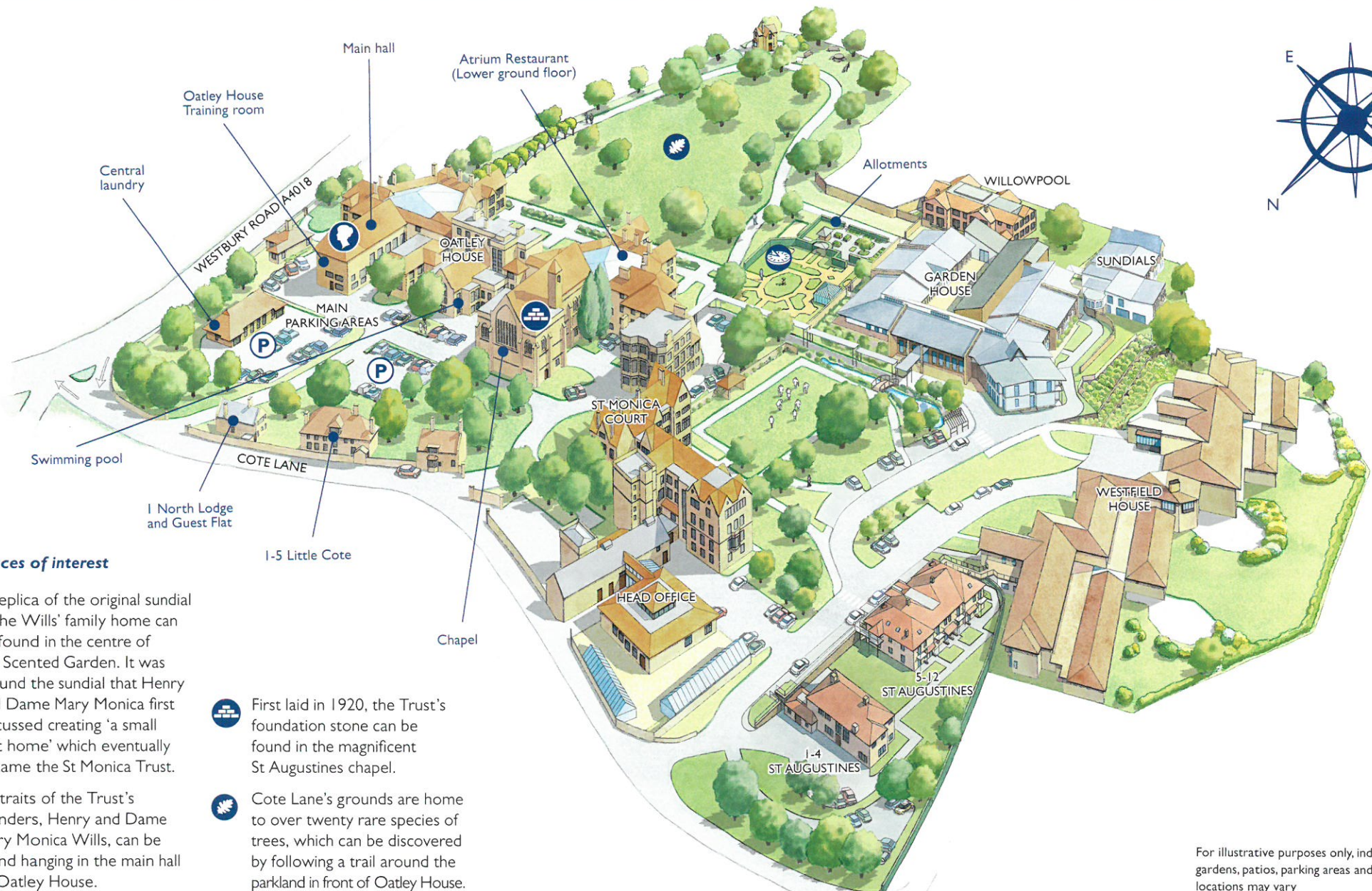

A replica of the original sundial at the Wills' family home can be found in the centre of the Scented Garden. It was around the sundial that Henry and Dame Mary Monica first discussed creating 'a small rest home' which eventually became the St Monica Trust.



First laid in 1920, the Trust's foundation stone can be found in the magnificent St Augustines chapel.



Portraits of the Trust's founders, Henry and Dame Mary Monica Wills, can be found hanging in the main hall of Oatley House.



Cote Lane's grounds are home to over twenty rare species of trees, which can be discovered by following a trail around the parkland in front of Oatley House.

HOW TO FIND US

By car

From the M5 motorway: the Cote Lane site is located on the A4018 (Westbury Road), three miles from J17 of the M5 and situated on the right hand side adjacent to Badminton School.

From the city centre: proceed along the A4018 from the top of Whiteladies Road and Cote Lane is the first turning on the left hand side after the White Tree roundabout.

Sat Nav

Enter the postcode **BS9 3UN** in your sat-nav.

Parking

Parking is available in the main parking areas which are located at the Oatley House end of the site.

By train

The nearest railway station is Clifton Down railway station off Whiteladies Road, just over 1 mile from Cote Lane. Trains run from all parts of the UK into **Bristol Temple Meads** in the city centre (4 miles away) and to **Bristol Parkway** to the north of the city (4.5 miles away).

By bus

The number **1** bus stop just outside Cote Lane on Westbury Road.

WHAT'S ON SITE?

Conferences

Conferences usually take place in the main hall in Oatley House. Arrangements will normally be made to access the hall via the door to the right of the main hall.

Chapel

Visitors to the chapel should use the glass doors at the western end of Oatley House.

Head Office

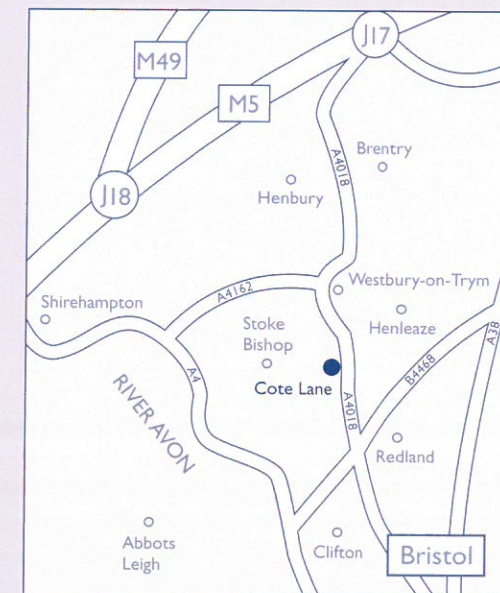
The Head Office is situated at the rear of St Monica Court at the western end of Cote Lane.

Swimming pool

The swimming pool is on the upper ground floor in Oatley House. Access is via the glass door at the western end of the building.

Training

Training usually takes place in either the training room at Head Office or the training room at the rear of the main hall of Oatley House. Please check with your training provider before attending.
