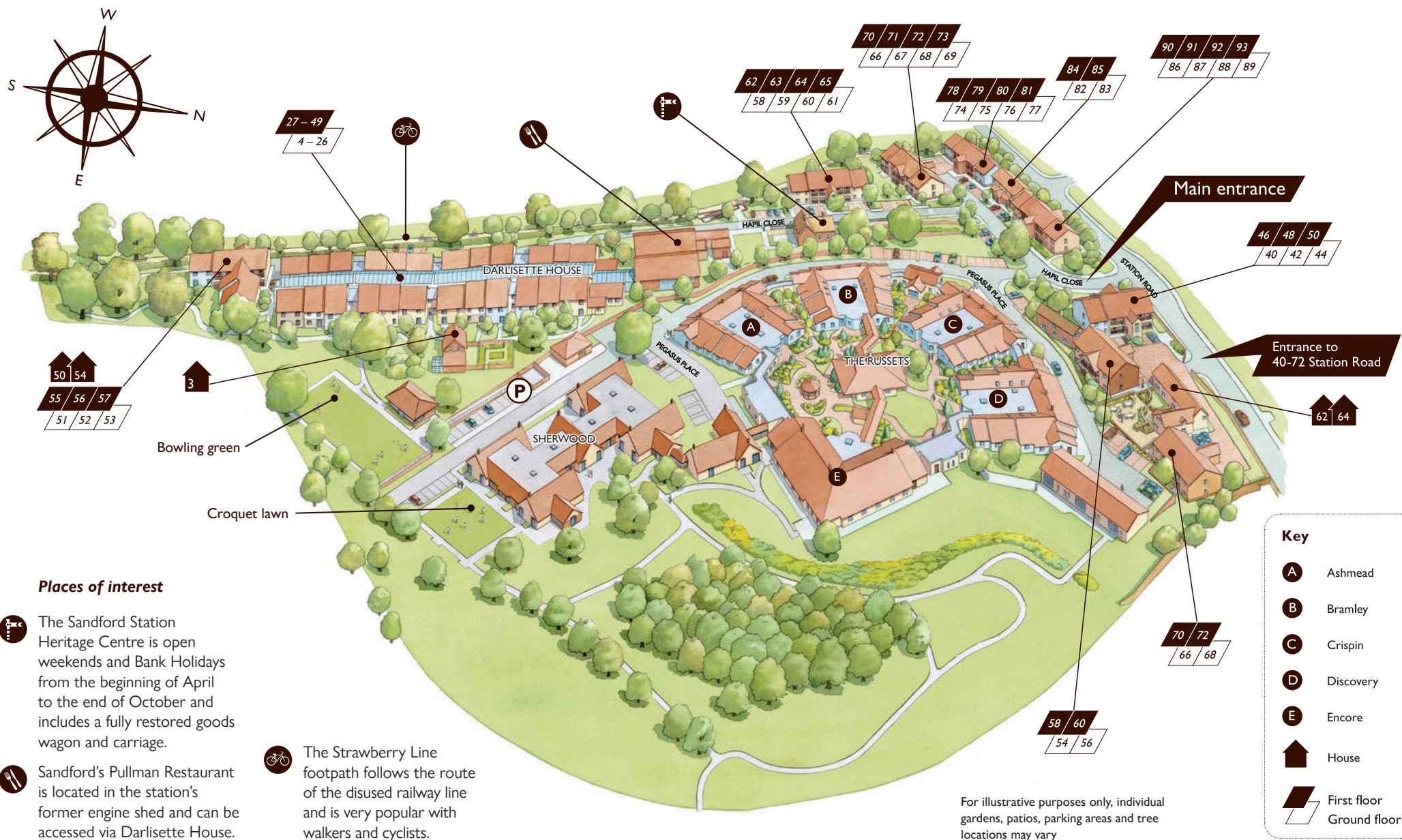


Sandford Station retirement village

Places of interest

The Sandford Station Heritage Centre is open weekends and Bank Holidays from the beginning of April to the end of October and includes a fully restored goods wagon and carriage.

Sandford's Pullman Restaurant is located in the station's former engine shed and can be accessed via Darlisette House.

The Strawberry Line footpath follows the route of the disused railway line and is very popular with walkers and cyclists.

HOW TO FIND US

By car

Heading south from Bristol, follow the A38 past Bristol International Airport for six miles. Turn right at the traffic lights onto the A368 (signposted for Weston-super-Mare) immediately after you pass through Churchill. Continue through the village of Sandford and the entrance to Sandford Station retirement village is on the left-hand side of the road, just after the Railway Inn.

Sat Nav

Enter the postcode **BS25 5AA** in your sat-nav.

By train

The nearest main railway station is Weston-super-Mare, seven miles from Sandford.

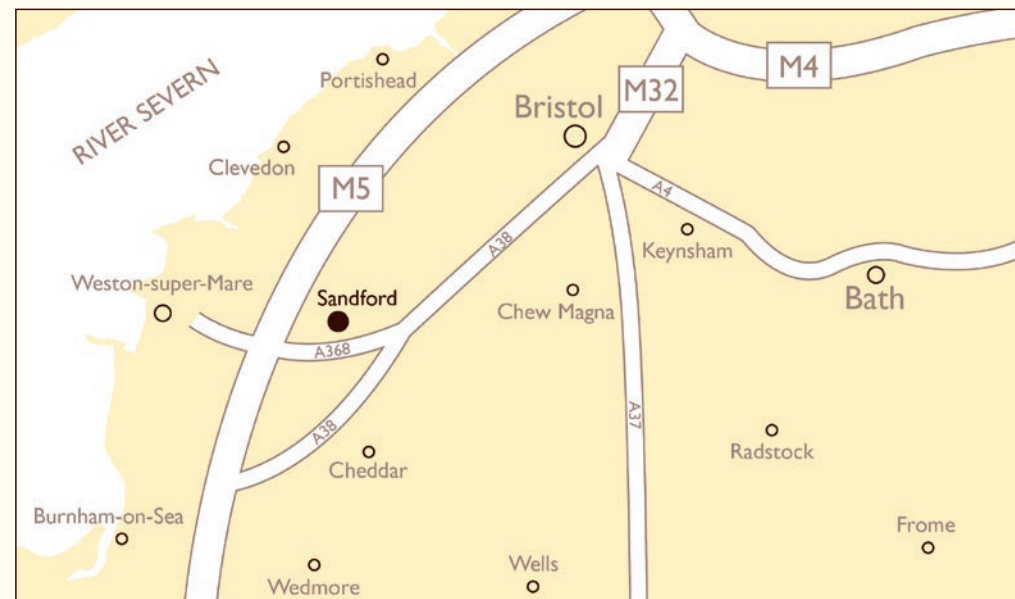
Parking

Parking is available on site at the top end of Pegasus Place, opposite Sherwood nursing care home. Pedestrians can access Darlisette House via a set of raised steps opposite The Russets.

By bus

The number **126** bus from Weston-super-Mare to Wells, via Locking, Winscombe, Axbridge and Cheddar.

Buses stop immediately outside the Sandford Station retirement village.
